FACTS	WHAT DOES WAILUKU FEDERAL CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?			
WHY?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing.			
WHAT?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: * Social Security Number * Overdraft History * Account Balances * Account Transactions * Transaction and loss history * Checking Account Information When you close your Wailuku Federal Credit Union account, we continue to share information about you as described in this notice.			
HOW?	Credit Union's need to share member's personal information to run their everyday business and to process transactions, maintain member accounts, and report to credit bureaus. In the section below, we list the reasons Wailuku Federal Credit Union can share their member's personal information; the reasons we choose to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Wailuku Federal Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.			
How does Wailuku Federal Credit Union collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: Open an account or apply for a loan Provide account or mortgage information Use your debit card Show your driver's license We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies			
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only: Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes- information about your creditworthiness Affiliates from using your information to market to you Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing 			
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • Wailuku Federal Credit Union has no affiliates			
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies • Nonaffiliates we share with can include insurance companies, government agencies, plastic card processors (debit/ATM), financial statement publishers or printers, mailhouse, mortgage service companies, consumer reporting agencies, data processors, check/share draft printers, and direct marketing companies.			
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies and financial service providers.
